

In response to the ample selection of Regional Spanish within the selector, we have also implemented three types of Regional English: USA, United Kingdom and Australia, from which to choose.

Click on TOOLS, and go to OPTIONS. There, under the GENERAL tab, in the subcategory named REGIONAL LANGUAGE, you will see the box for English. When you click on the dropdown arrow next to it, you will see the menu where you can choose the type of English. For demonstration purposes, we will select the English form UNITED KINGDOM. Click on ACCEPT and close the OPTIONS window. Then type:

Abordemos el autobús y más tarde caminaremos.

Autobús has its own regional word in the United Kingdom: COACH. If you click on the interactive button, you will see the translation of this sentence using the word COACH for autobús, instead of the more neutral BUS. As you can see, the program prefers this term and uses it as the first option, per your instructions. If you hadn't selected a regional English, the default translation would have been BUS.
